Cerza Zoo

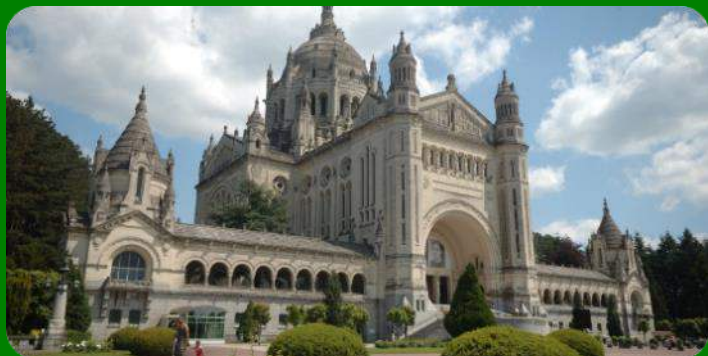
