Our centres are specifically designed for children and youth groups, featuring sports facilities, expansive grounds for quality downtime, and full security measures to ensure dietary needs and safeguarding are met.

Domaine de Soignolles (above): Ideal for smaller groups, this venue is a popular wedding location with beautiful grounds and excellent facilities.

Orangerie Bourg-Saint-Leonard (below): A larger centre set within the grounds of an 18th-century château, which can be explored on your stay.

Maison Saint Georges: Perfect for very large groups, this centre is located within school grounds in the charming countryside town of Orbec.





Medieval History - The famous Bayeux Tapestry Museum and the Château de Falaise (William the Conqueror's castle) reveal the dramatic history of Normandy. Mont Saint Michel is a magical experience nearby.

Modern History - The **D-Day Landing Beaches** can be experienced via the circular cinema **Arromanches 360** and the beach below, which still contains the remnants of the artificial harbour from WW2.

Prehistory - Exploring 'Jurassic Normandy', the **Paléospace l'Odyssée** at Villers-sur-Mer organise fascinating dinosaur and fossil workshops, followed by a beach visit where the students can hunt for fossils.

Cheese - The Pays d'Auge is renowned for its four cheeses - Neufchâtel, Pont l'Evêque, Livarot, and Camembert. At the **Village Fromager** in Livarot, students can learn about the art of cheese-making with tastings at the end.

Chocolate - The **Drakkar Chocolate Museum** in Bayeux organise tours for students to learn about these famous regional delicacies.

Market Morning - Traditional French markets are found all over our region. The 'Marchée aux Poissons' in Trouville-sur-Mer is engaging as the fishermen unload their catches directly onto the quayside.

Festyland is always a hit with school groups,
with a lovely range of rides suitable for all
levels of confidence. The stunning Suisse

Normande (the area of Normandy
reminiscent of the Swiss Alps) is home to
aerial trekking, kayaking, geo-caching and
archery. Not forgetting Normandy's one-andonly bobsleigh circuit Clecy Gliss!

We have an ever-expanding list of French schools that are keen to welcome UK school groups into their classrooms. Your students can experience life in a French school with students of the same year-group. Your teachers and the French teachers have regular contact to plan the in-school activities. All the students can also enjoy school canteen lunch together (French-style: starter/main/cheese/dessert!).

Our company also organises school music tours, therefore we can include a musical element. This might be a tour of a the Lisieux Conservatoire, with a short performance given by the conservatoire's senior students. Or perhaps a collaborative singing project bringing your school together with a local choir to meet, rehearse, and perform some songs which are prepared in advance.
